A motion was made by Mr. Voorheis, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$828,496.16. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the November 4, 2019 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Keller reported that the scheduled tour of the new Water Reclamation Facility was held prior to this meeting.

Mr. Keller also reported that recently the main power feed for the Wastewater Treatment Plant burned in two after the switch gear before the main distribution which knocked the power completely out at the plant. Mr. Keller indicated that Mr. Eric Gottfried, Gottfried Electric, was able to get the electric back on and he is still working to repair the issue.

Mr. Schoenberger presented a quote from Ferguson Waterworks for a full water meter change over with a fixed base system. The cost of these meters, accessories, and services is \$1,349,526.28. Mr. Schoenberger indicated that Mr. Jeff Garrett from Ferguson Waterworks has been invited to give a presentation to the Service Committee at the December 16, 2019 meeting.

Mr. Schoenberger reported that he will be meeting with representatives from Neptune Equipment tomorrow to again discuss the meter program.

Mr. Taylor reported that the Street Department is still in the process of picking up leaves throughout the City.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
