A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Voorheis, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$458,707.63. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the December 2, 2019 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Jeff Garrett, Ferguson Waterworks, and Mr. Mike Phillips, Master Meter, presented information on new metering technology for the Octave Ultrasonic Meter. Customer service tools were explained including an app that customers can download on their cellphone to alert them of their usage and any leaks. A licensed radio frequency will be required to read meters throughout the City. Warranty information for the meters was also explained. The approximate cost of these meters is \$1,400,000.00 including a company that would take care of installing all of the meters. Service Committee members will further consider the information provided.

Mr. Taylor indicated that the Wyandot County Recycling Center has provided a new recycling trailer and he would like to list the existing trailer that is owned by the City for sale on govdeals.com.

A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Voorheis, to authorize the City's existing recycling trailer to be listed for sale on govdeals.com. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
