

CITY COUNCIL

January 21, 2020

The January 21, 2020 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Rick Roberts, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Kyle McColly, Rick Roberts, Don Spiegel, John Walker, Kenneth Wessler, Aaron Korte, and Marc Mays.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Ben Buckland, Law Director; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the January 2, 2020 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the January 6, 2020 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the January 6, 2020 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

A motion was made by Mr. Korte, seconded by Mr. Walker, to place Ordinance No. 74-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, WYANDOT COUNTY, OHIO, IN THE MATTER OF THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED IMPROVEMENT AND TO REQUEST THE COOPERATION OF THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 74-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Mays, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 74-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 74-13 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Mays, seconded by Mr. Walker, to place Ordinance No. 75-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A BACKHOE LOADER, HYDRAULIC HAMMER, AND ACCESSORIES THROUGH THE STATE PURCHASING PROGRAM.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 75-13 for the first time by title only.

Mr. Wessler thanked the high school students who helped load the Winter Fantasy of Lights trailers in Harrison Smith Park on Monday, January 20, 2020.

Mayor Washburn reported that there will be a conference call tomorrow regarding a requested safety study for the area near Love's Travel Stop on North Warpole Street.

It was noted that the recapitulation for the month of December 2019 was received by the members of City Council.

Mayor Washburn presented the reappointment of Mr. Paul Wymer to the Board of Zoning Appeals for the four year term. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
