A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. McColly, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$12,112.08. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the January 6, 2020 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

At this time Mr. Dave Yeater, on behalf of the Wyandot Classics and Cruisers, addressed the Safety Committee requesting permission for the car club to hold their 20th annual Autumn Cruise in the downtown area on Saturday, September 26, 2020. Safety Committee members voiced no objections to this request.

At this time Mr. Blake England and Mr. Jeremy Stringfellow, organizers of the St. Pete's Festival, addressed the Safety Committee indicating that they would like to change the festival to a two day event by adding Saturday and also adding a parade on Sunday. The festival will be held on Saturday, June 13, 2020 and Sunday, June 14, 2020 with Saturday being primarily for adults and Sunday being for families. The parade on Sunday will begin at the Upper Sandusky High School and head south on North Eighth Street and end at the St. Paul Lutheran Church parking lot. The closure of a portion of West Finley Street for the festival was discussed and Mr. England indicated that the street would need to be closed from 6:00 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. on Saturday and from 12:00 p.m. (noon) to 6:00 p.m. on Sunday. The organizers will work with Chief Ross on the street closures for this event. Safety Committee members voted no objections to this request as presented.

Safety Committee members reviewed a retirement notice from Police Lieutenant Eric Parks, effective April 18, 2020.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Roberts, to accept the retirement of Police Lieutenant Eric Parks effective April 18, 2020. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Chief Ross reported that the Police Department is in the early stages of promotions and hirings.

Chief MaGinn reported that Perry Pro Tech is working to get the Fire Department their own internet and this should be ready by the end of the month.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
