May 4, 2020

The May 4, 2020 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. via Zoom by Rick Roberts, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Marc Mays, Kyle McColly, Rick Roberts, Don Spiegel, John Walker, Kenneth Wessler, and Aaron Korte.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Ben Buckland, Law Director; Mark Droll, City Auditor; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the April 20, 2020 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

Mr. Roberts reported that he was contacted by Fire Chief Mike MaGinn who indicated that the Fire Department's ladder truck was recently serviced to repair a defective component which was sending error alarms related to the transmission.

City Council members reviewed the April credit card statements and voiced no objections to these statements.

Mayor Washburn reported that an invitation will be extended to all graduating members of the Upper Sandusky High School Class of 2020 to participate in a Senior Cruise to be held on Thursday, May 21, 2020. The cruise will leave the fairgrounds promptly at 6:00 p.m. and lead the graduates to their private commencement ceremony at the Upper Sandusky High School beginning at 7:00 p.m. The cruise route is as follows: 1. Traveling south on North Sandusky Avenue to Village View Acres and continuing south on Fifth Street, crossing over East Wyandot Avenue, to East Johnson Street; 2. West on East Johnson Street to South Sandusky Avenue; 3. South on South Sandusky Avenue to Fairview Street; 4. West on Fairview Street to Marseilles Avenue; 5. North on Marseilles Avenue, continuing north on Eighth Street, to Hought Drive; 6. East on Hought Drive to the Upper Sandusky High School. While adhering to social distancing guideline, due to the current coronavirus pandemic, the community is asked to join by lining the cruise route to offer congratulations and well wishes to the Upper Sandusky Class of 2020. Mayor Washburn also noted that this event has no affiliation with the Upper Sandusky Schools.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
