

CITY COUNCIL

May 18, 2020

The May 18, 2020 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. via Zoom by Rick Roberts, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Kyle McColly, Rick Roberts, Don Spiegel, John Walker, Kenneth Wessler, Aaron Korte, and Marc Mays.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Ben Buckland, Law Director; Mark Droll, City Auditor; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the May 4, 2020 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the May 11, 2020 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

Mr. McColly inquired as to if there will be a Memorial Day parade this year. Mayor Washburn reported that there will not be a Memorial Day parade this year and the VFW is planning a private ceremony in honor of Memorial Day.

It was noted that City Council members received the recapitulation for April 2020.

Mayor Washburn read a letter from Mrs. Deanna Piecha, Human Resource Coordinator, who will be retiring on July 24, 2020. Upon Roll Call, City Council members unanimously voted in favor of accepting Mrs. Piecha's retirement as the Human Resource Coordinator.

Line-up for the cruise will begin at the fairgrounds at 5:30 p.m. and leave the fairgrounds promptly at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Washburn invited available City Council members to assist with staging the vehicles at the fairgrounds, and he asked members to wear their red City of Upper Sandusky issued shirts for identification purposes.
