The minutes of the June 15, 2020 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the June 15, 2020 Tree Commission meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the June 15, 2020 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the June 16, 2020 Board of Zoning Appeals hearings, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

A motion was made by Mr. Mays, seconded by Mr. Wessler, to place Ordinance No. 82-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO TO ACCESS FEDERAL FUNDING THROUGH THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT, 116 PUBLIC LAW 136 (THE CARES ACT), AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 82-13 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Mays, to suspend the rules of the Municipal Charter calling for separate readings on different days. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. McColly, seconded by Mr. Walker, to place Ordinance No. 82-13 on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 82-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Korte, seconded by Mr. Mays, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 82-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 82-13 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Korte, seconded by Mr. Walker, to place Ordinance No. 83-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 335.09 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO RELATING TO THE DISPLAY OF A LICENSE PLATE ON A MOTOR VEHICLE, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 83-13 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Mays, to suspend the rules of the Municipal Charter calling for separate readings on different days. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Korte, seconded by Mr. McColly, to place Ordinance No. 83-13 on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 83-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Korte, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 83-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 83-13 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Walker, to place Ordinance No. 84-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH LINK COMPUTER CORPORATION FOR A SUBSCRIPTION TO MUNI-LINK UTILITY BILLING SOFTWARE SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS CONSISTENT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 84-13 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Korte, seconded by Mr. Walker, to place Resolution No. 85-13 entitled, "A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN UPDATED REVOLVING LOAN FUND (RLF) PLAN AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A REVOLVING LOAN ADMINISTRATIVE CONTRACT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO AND TO ADMINISTER THE REVOLVING LOAN FUND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED BY THE OHIO DEVELOPMENT SERVICES AGENCY AND THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RLF PLAN AND GUIDELINES DEVELOPED FOR THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY AND APPROVED BY THE OHIO DEVELOPMENT SERVICES AGENCY, OFFICE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Resolution No. 85-13 for the first time by title only.

Discussion was held concerning the 2021 estimate of budget revenues, as reviewed in the Budget Hearing held prior to this meeting.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Mays, to approve the submission of the 2021 budget revenues to the Wyandot County Budget Commission. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

It was noted that there have been many compliments received on the fireworks display that was held on Friday, July 3, 2020.
