A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. McColly, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$15,995.49. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the June 1, 2020 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Chief MaGinn reported that the Fire Department recently fought one of the City's largest fires at Dlubak Glass. It was noted that mutual aid from area Fire Departments was called assisted with the fire. Chief MaGinn noted that the City's water system was tested and it did well. Chief MaGinn thanked the Police Department for assisting with crowd control.

Chief MaGinn again reported on the air compressor needed at the Fire Department. Chief MaGinn indicated that he has discussed the purchase of a new air compressor with the Mayor and the City Auditor, and he is currently waiting on a decision of an application for grant funding that was submitted. Chief MaGinn noted that new bottles will also be needed, and the existing compressor can be recalibrated to temporarily extend its life. Safety Committee members indicated that they will work with the Mayor, the Auditor, and Chief MaGinn to obtain a new air compressor. Following the meeting Chief MaGinn showed the members of the Safety Committee the existing air compressor.

Mr. Wessler thanked the Fire Department for their assistance with the fireworks on Friday, July 3, 2020 and for the excellent dinners they provided from their annual chicken barbeque held on Saturday, July 4, 2020.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
