Mr. Niederkohr noted that he is working with Mrs. Jennifer Banta on the setup for Trunk-or-Treat to take place in Harrison Smith Park on Saturday, October 31, 2020 from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Park Board members thanked Mayor Washburn for his support over the years, as he will be resigning as Mayor prior to the next Park Board meeting.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
