The November 2, 2020 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Aaron Korte, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Kenneth Wessler, Aaron Korte, Marc Mays, Rick Roberts, Don Spiegel, and John Walker.
