A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Roberts, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$13,888.10. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the October 5, 2020 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the October 15, 2020 special Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Safety Committee members again discussed the request from Pastor Rodney Donohoo, Apostolic Gospel Church, for the east/west alley located between the church located at 221 North Fifth Street and the adjacent house to the south to be designated one way westbound, as presented at the October 5, 2020 Safety Committee meeting. Mr. Wessler indicated that he would like to table this matter.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Roberts, to table the request from the Apostolic Gospel Church to designate the east/west alley located between the church and the adjacent house to the south as one way westbound. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Chief Ross reported that Mr. Nathan Fawcett will be sworn in as a Police Officer on Monday, November 9, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. and he will begin working on Sunday, November 15, 2020.

Chief Ross also reported that Mr. Theodore Frumkin is currently in the process of attaining the necessary physical examination for a Police Officer position, as set forth by the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund.

Chief Ross further reported that he is hoping that one of the new police cruisers will be delivered next week ready for service and the other police cruiser will be delivered soon.

Chief MaGinn reported that the Fire Department had a crew and a truck stationed at the intersection of West Johnson Street and South Eighth Street during Trick-or-Treat held on Saturday, October 31, 2020. Chief MaGinn noted that the Fire Department also participated in Trunk-or-Treat held in Harrison Smith Park on Saturday, October 31, 2020.

Chief MaGinn also reported that the Fire Department has tested over 5000' of fire hose with approximately 5000' of fire hose remaining to be tested.

Chief MaGinn stated that the Fire Department's display for the Winter Fantasy of Lights will be set up this week.

Chief MaGinn indicated that interviews have been and will continue to be conducted for new Volunteer Firemen.

Chief MaGinn further reported that the FEMA grant application that the Fire Department amended, previously requesting funding for air packs and now requesting funding for an air compressor, has been extended for another year.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
