A motion was made by Mr. Voorheis, seconded by Mr. Mays, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$65,404.83. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the October 5, 2020 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Bruce Brandstetter and Mr. Jeff McMullen, Brandstetter Carroll, Inc., addressed the Service Committee regarding the extension of approximately 1000 linear feet of water and sewer lines located in the area of Tarhe Trail to be extended north to the land across US 23/30. Mr. Brandstetter indicated that the project would extend a 12" water line and either a 6" or 8" forced sewer main with casing for both lines through a directional bore under the highway to provide future service to the land to the north of the highway. Mr. Brandstetter indicated that the Ohio Department of Transportation has approved the plans for the project. The estimated cost of this project is \$300,000.00 to \$330,000.00, and the bid opening will take place in November 2020 with construction to possibly begin in December 2020, weather permitting. Mayor Washburn indicated that the project is needed for future development in this area and Mr. Greg Moon, Wyandot County Economic Development Director, is working on possible grant funding for this project.

Mr. Schoenberger reported that the new river pump will be installed on Thursday, October 22, 2020.

Mr. Schoenberger, on behalf of the Water Department, congratulated Mayor Washburn on the new position he will be taking next month following his resignation and thanked him for his support over the years.

Mr. Taylor reported that leaf pick-up within the City will begin tomorrow.

Mr. Taylor thanked Mayor Washburn for his support over the years.

Mr. Schneider also thanked Mayor Washburn for his support over the years.

Mr. Thornton reported that the Water Department employees will finish flushing fire hydrants tomorrow.

Mr. Thornton also reported that the swimming pool in Harrison Smith Park was closed today for the year.

Mayor Washburn thanked everyone for their service to the City during his tenure as Mayor and wished them well in their future endeavors with the City.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
