A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Mays, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$210,898.47. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the November 2, 2020 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

At this time a drawing was held for trapping rights at the reservoir for the 2020/2021 season. Mr. Steven Webster was drawn for these rights and Mr. Jared Lucas was drawn as the alternate.

Mr. Keller reported that there will be a major start up at the new Water Reclamation Facility this week.

Mr. Schoenberger reported that the river pump was installed recently.

Mr. Schoenberger also reported that a different company will be cleaning the membranes at the Water Treatment Plant using different chemicals that have previously been used as part of a cleaning study. Mr. Schoenberger noted that a quote was received for a skid (120 pieces) of membranes to replace part of the membranes at the Water Treatment Plant at a cost of \$93,000.00.

Mr. Taylor reported that leaf pick-up within the City continues. Mr. Taylor noted that last week there were sanitation employees off sick and Parks Department and Water Department employees assisted with trash pick-up.

Mr. Thornton reported that fire hydrants were flushed recently and there were some that required minor repairs and next week some fire hydrants will be pumped out for the winter months.

Mr. McColly indicated that he plans to discuss the Water Treatment Plant membrane replacement with City Council at their meeting to be held later this evening.

It was noted that one of the summer help workers will be working over the winter months.

Mr. Taylor reported that a letter of resignation was received from Mr. Treyc Stansbery, effective November 27, 2020.

A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Mays, to accept the resignation of Mr. Treyc Stansbery, effective November 27, 2020. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Mays, to authorize the Mayor to advertise for an open position in the Street and Sanitation Department. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
