

## CITY COUNCIL

May 17, 2021

The May 17, 2021 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in the conference room at the Water Treatment Plant by Aaron Korte, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were John Walker, Kenneth Wessler, Aaron Korte, Marc Mays, Kate Niederkohr, Rick Roberts, and Don Spiegel.

Others present included: Kyle McColly, Mayor; Ben Buckland, Law Director; Mark Droll, City Auditor; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the May 3, 2021 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

Mr. Mays reminded residents that with the upcoming Memorial Day holiday on Monday, May 31, 2021, trash that would normally be picked-up on Monday will be picked up on Tuesday, June 1, 2021.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts, seconded by Mr. Walker, to place Ordinance No. 109-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE CREATING CHAPTER 727 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO TO AUTHORIZE AND REGULATE MOBILE FOOD VENDORS OPERATING WITHIN THE CITY.", on its second reading, as amended, by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 109-13 for the second time, as amended, by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Walker, seconded by Mr. Mays, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 109-13, as amended. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 109-13 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mrs. Niederkohr, to place Ordinance No. 110-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF MEMBRANES FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 110-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Walker, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 110-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 110-13 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Mays, seconded by Mr. Korte, to place Ordinance No. 111-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 95-13, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 111-13 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts, seconded by Mr. Walker, to suspend the rules of the Municipal Charter calling for separate readings on different days. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Roberts, to place Ordinance No. 111-13 on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 111-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mrs. Niederkohr, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 111-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried an Ordinance No. 111-13 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Korte, to place Resolution No. 112-13 entitled, "A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE DRAFT WYANDOT COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR SUBMISSION TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Resolution No. 112-13 for the first time by title only.

City Council members reviewed the Recapitulation for April 2021.

Mayor McColly was asked if there has been a meeting held to look at flooding issues in Brookview Subdivision. Mayor McColly indicated that meeting has not happened.

Mayor McColly reported that Mr. Chuck Ulrich has submitted his resignation from the Board of Zoning Appeals, and he has contacted Mr. Tom Karcher and asked if he would be willing to fill Mr. Ulrich's term until the end of 2021 and Mr. Karcher accepted.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts, seconded by Mr. Walker, to approve the appointment of Mr. Tom Karcher to the Board of Zoning Appeals thru December 31, 2021. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

Mayor McColly indicated that the City is accepting donations for the fireworks display to take place on Friday, July 2, 2021.

It was noted that there will be an upcoming series of public hearings held to discuss the branding initiative being proposed within the county, with the first public hearing to be held on Thursday, June 10, 2021 at John Stewart United Methodist Church beginning at 3:00 p.m.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
