

CITY COUNCIL

May 3, 2021

The May 3, 2021 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Aaron Korte, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of the United States of America. City Council members present were Don Spiegel, John Walker, Kenneth Wessler, Aaron Korte, Marc Mays, Kate Niederkohr, and Rick Roberts.

Others present included: Kyle McColly, Mayor; Ben Buckland, Law Director; Eric Trautwein; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the April 19, 2021 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the April 19, 2021 Tree Commission meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the April 19, 2021 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the April 22, 2021 Board of Zoning Appeals hearings, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

Mr. Eric Trautwein, a resident of Brookview Subdivision, inquired with City Council members as to the status of any plans to address flooding issues in the subdivision. Mayor McColly indicated that there is a potential meeting pending to look at the flooding issues.

It was noted that Ordinance No. 109-13, addressing mobile food trucks, has been amended to address concerns including a one time permit fee and trash removal.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Walker, to remove Ordinance No. 109-13 from the table, as it was tabled at the April 19, 2021 City Council meeting. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Walker, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, to place Ordinance No. 109-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE CREATING CHAPTER 727 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO TO AUTHORIZE AND REGULATE MOBILE FOOD VENDORS OPERATING WITHIN THE CITY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Mays, seconded by Mrs. Niederkohr, to place Ordinance No. 110-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF MEMBRANES FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 110-13 for the first time by title only.

Mr. Korte indicated that the May 17, 2021 City Council meeting will take place at the Water Treatment Plant with a tour of the plant to take place before the meeting.

City Council members expressed that a nice job was done by the City's sanitation employees during the week of Spring Clean-Up.

City Council members reviewed the credit card statements for April 2021.

A motion was made by Mr. Mays, seconded by Mr. Walker, to approve the April 2021 credit card statements. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

City Council members reviewed the Recapitulation for March 2021.

Mayor McColly reported that a negotiating team meeting will be held tomorrow morning at 9:30 a.m. in Council Chambers to review an application received for a proposed project requesting a tax abatement. Mayor McColly indicated that he and Mr. Korte will be attending this meeting and he inquired as to if another City Council member would like to volunteer to also attend the meeting. Mr. Mays volunteered to attend this meeting.

It was noted that construction of the electric vehicle charging station located in the parking lot behind the Municipal Building is almost completed.

Mr. Buckland thanked the food truck subcommittee for their work in preparing regulations for food trucks.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
