A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Voorheis, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$193,306.25. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the April 5, 2021 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Taylor requested permission to sell an approximate 1970's model Oliver tractor, located at the Street garage, on govdeals.com. Mr. Taylor indicated that a quote was received for new tires for this tractor and the value of the tires quoted would be more than the value of the tractor.

A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Voorheis, to authorize the 1970's model Oliver tractor be listed for sale on govdeals.com. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mr. Eric Trautwein, Brookview Subdivision resident, addressed the Service Committee and inquired as to there have been any findings regarding issues with flooding in Brookview Subdivision, as presented and discussed at the April 5, 2021 Service Committee and City Council meetings. It was noted that Mr. Schneider, Collections System Supervisor, televised the 18" storm drain and determined that there is no blockage. Mayor McColly reported that meetings concerning this issue are happening in effort to determine the best options and residents in the area will be notified of the findings.

Mr. Schoenberger reported that tomorrow will kick off the asset management system with Dude Solutions as approved at the April 5, 2021 Service Committee meeting.

Mr. Schoenberger also reported that representatives from the City will be traveling to Vermillion, Ohio on Tuesday, April 27, 2021 to look at Neptune water meters. It was noted that City representatives recently visited Defiance, Ohio and observed Mastermeter water meters.

Mr. Schoenberger further reported that flushing of fire hydrants has been postponed due to the incoming winter storm.

Mr. Taylor reported that the snowplows will be put back on the trucks tomorrow to deal with snowfall from the incoming winter storm.

Mayor McColly reported that the Water Treatment Plant and the Fire Department are working together on the issue of compatibility with the fire hydrants as discussed at the February 1, 2021 Service Committee meeting.

Mr. Taylor also reported that Spring Clean-Up for residential sanitation customers is next week.

Mayor McColly also reported that the construction of the electric car charging station in the rear parking lot of the Municipal Building is moving along.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
