POOL OPENING

The pool will open (weather permitting) on Memorial Day weekend (Saturday, May 29, Sunday, May 30, and Monday, May 31, 2021) and will reopen for the season on Saturday, June 5, 2021. Pool hours are as follows:

The final weekday of the 2021 swimming pool season will be Sunday, August 22, 2021. The Park Board will attempt to keep the pool open on the weekends thru Labor Day, September 6, 2021 (weather permitting).

Season tickets will be available for purchase at the Water Office in the City Building.

HARRISON SMITH PARK POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Obey all lifeguards and pool staff.
2. Use of profanity is prohibited.
3. No tobacco products inside the pool and bathhouse area.
4. No gum in the pool area. Food and drinks permitted at the discretion of the pool staff.
5. Bathing suits, basketball shorts, or other appropriate attire is required.
6. No running.
7. No dunking.
8. No diving from the sides of the pool except in the deep area.
9. Children shall not be left unattended in the wading pool.
10. All swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
11. Nerf balls, inflatable toys, etc. allowed in the pool with permission from pool personnel only. These items are allowed in the wading pool. No squirt guns or similar toys permitted in the pool area.
12. No children under the age of 9 will be admitted without an adult supervisor.
13. The pool is reserved for adult swimmers during rest periods. Swimmers must be 18 years of age or a recent high school graduate to swim during rest periods.
14. All swimmers under the age of 18 will leave the water during the ten minute rest period every hour.
15. Children are not permitted to enter the pool during rest periods unless they are receiving instruction or are totally dependent on adult supervision.
16. Long hair shall be controlled by braids or bands or covered by a bathing cap. (This keeps the pool clear.)
17. In the event of closing due to storms, rain checks or refunds will be issued to registered daily admissions only if the swimmer has been there less than two hours.
18. Only children age 6 and under or disabled children are permitted in the wading pool with adult supervision.
19. Only children ages 3 and under shall be admitted to the pool free of charge during regular hours.

DIVING BOARD RULES: No diving to the side, divers must go off the end of the board. Divers must wait until the diving area is clear before going off the board. Only one bounce on the diving board is permitted. Divers in the water must vacate the area without delay.

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

Failure to follow the above pool rules and regulations will result in the following disciplinary actions:

1st Offense - Swimmers will have to sit on a bench for a period of time to be determined by the pool staff.

2nd Offense - At the discretion of the Manager or Assistant Manager, swimmers will have to leave the pool for the day, if possible, their parents will be contacted and notified of the situation.

3rd Offense - At the discretion of the Manager, swimmers will not be permitted to return to the pool for the remainder of the season.

Other actions (not listed in the above rules and regulations) requiring disciplinary action will be handled at the discretion of the pool manager or assistant manager.

Anyone attempting to gain entry into the pool by using a pool pass that does not belong to them will not be permitted to return to the pool until proper payment (including any outstanding payments for prior entries) is received. At the discretion of the manager, such individuals may not be permitted to return to the pool for the remainder of the season.

OPENING/CLOSING POLICY

The air temperature must be approximately 70 degrees to open. The Manager may use his or her discretion for the opening of the pool during extenuating circumstances. Once open, there must be a minimum of 12 swimmers present or after a 2 hour period the pool will be closed.

During storms everyone must exit from the pool area immediately when the pool staff has heard thunder. Shower areas in the bathhouse will remain open to provide shelter during severe storms. Pool staff should wait twenty minutes after lightning is last sighted or a storm has passed before allowing swimmers to enter the pool. If the pool is closed due to weather, a sign will be placed on the door stating that the pool will reopen as soon as weather permits.

The swimming pool will close early or open late for home swim team meets; the dates of those meets are to be determined. The final weekday of the 2021 swimming pool season, as determined by the Upper Sandusky Park Board, is scheduled for Sunday, August 22, 2021; with the pool to open on the weekends thru Labor Day, September 6, 2021.
