

CITY COUNCIL

August 17, 2009

The August 17, 2009 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Gary Veith, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Gary Veith, Paul Wagner, Evie Hall-Case, Mike Kuenzli, Bud Miller, Chad Smith, and Scot Swinehart.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Sam Molnar; Alissa Paoella, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Molnar, Clerk.

The minutes of the August 3, 2009 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the August 4, 2009 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the August 10, 2009 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the August 11, 2009 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

Mayor Washburn and City Council members expressed their appreciation and wished good luck to Ms. Alissa Paoella, Daily Chief Union, as she will be leaving her position with the newspaper and returning to college.

It was reported that the City's new water tower, located along Malabar Drive, is nearing completion.

It was noted that there is some confusion within the community, due to an error in a recent newspaper article, with residents thinking the City will be tearing down the water tower located along Indian Mill Drive, near the City garage. City Council members clarified that the City's water plant will be torn down after the new water plant is built near the reservoir. Mr. Veith explained the need for the new water plant and the reasons for tearing down the old plant.

City Council members agreed that due to the next scheduled City Council meeting falling on Labor Day, the meeting will be moved to Tuesday, September 8, 2009 to begin at 7:30 p.m. following the Service Committee meeting.

City Council members reviewed the recapitulation for July 2009.

Mayor Washburn reported that the Wyandot County Midget Football League has thanked the City for the use of bleachers for a scrimmage held on Saturday, August 15, 2009 at Union School.

It was noted that the annual picnic at Mr. Ellis's cabin for City Council members will be held on Thursday, August 27, 2009.
