

CITY COUNCIL

February 2, 2009

The February 2, 2009 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Gary Veith, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members again discussed the appointment of an individual to replace Mrs. Carol King on the Civil Service Commission. Mr. Gary Veith indicated that he has asked Mrs. Tammy Clifford if she would be interested in the appointment and she has indicated that she would be willing to serve on the Civil Service Commission.

A motion was made by Mr. Veith, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to appoint Mrs. Tammy Clifford to the Civil Service Commission, to replace Mrs. Carol King, with her term to expire March 1, 2014. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.
