A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. The minutes of the August 2nd, 2010, City Council meeting, having been mailed to each member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the August 2nd, 2010 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the August 2nd, 2010 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the August 5th, 2010 Board of Zoning Appeals meeting, having been mailed to each member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the August 9th, 2010 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each member, were reviewed.

Jacob Stansbery; David Forwalder II; and David Forwalder Jr. of Boy Scout Troop 221 were welcomed by City Council in order to obtain merit badges.

A motion was made by Mr. Chad Smith, seconded by Mr. Scot Swinehart, to place Ordinance No. 32-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 9-12, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31ST, 2010, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading, by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 32-12 for the first time, by title only.

Discussion was held concerning a special use permit request filed by Ms. Lisa Thiel to open a beauty shop (with 4 operators or less) at 490 North Seventh Street. It was noted that all public hearings have been held regarding this permit. A motion was made by Mr. Don Spiegel, seconded by Mrs. Hall-Case, to grant the special use permit as requested by Ms. Thiel. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding the September 6th, 2010 City Council and Safety Committee meeting. City Council unanimously agreed to change these meeting to September 7th, 2010 in order to observe the Labor Day Holiday.

Mayor Washburn and City Council commended lifeguards Ashleigh Kline, Jacob Beach, Mary Stansbery and Tyler Billeg for their efforts in saving the life of a 4 year old boy at the pool. Mayor Washburn noted that these individuals will be recognized at town hall meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
