

CITY COUNCIL
SEPTEMBER 17, 2012

The September 4th, 2012 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Mr. Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Don Spiegel, Scot Swinehart, Bill Thornton, Evie Hall- Case, Kyle McColly, Rick Roberts, and Chad Smith.

Others present included: Scott D. Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Larry Brandstetter, Brandstetter and Carroll, Inc.; Chanda Neely, Daily Chief Union; Bob Steiert; and Linda K. Stansbery, Administrative Assistant.

The minutes of the September 4th, 2012 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the September 4, 2012 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each member, were reviewed.

Discussion was held concerning a high water bill at the Senior Village. It was noted that Mr. Dave Westbrook, Water Plant Supervisor, could be contacted regarding an irrigation meter.

Discussion was held concerning the blue flag water locators for the Northeast Quadrant waterline. It was noted that residents can remove these flags.

The minutes of the September 4th, 2012 Planning Commission meeting, having been mailed to each member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the September 4th, 2012 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each members, were reviewed.

At this time, Mr. Larry Brandstetter of Brandstetter & Carroll Engineering presented a Gold Medal Client Award to City Council members to extend their appreciation for the 30 years of business. City Council extended their appreciation to Mr. Brandstetter.

A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Roberts, to place Resolution No. 109-12 entitled, "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC) STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its second reading, by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried. The Acting Clerk read Resolution No. 109-12 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, for the adoption of Resolution 109-12. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Resolution 109-12 was duly adopted.

Discussion was held concerning the Indian Mill Rd Slope project. It was noted that residents will be cited if they are caught driving through the barricades.

Mayor Washburn reported that fall cleanup is scheduled for September 24th through September 28th.

Mayor Washburn reported on a trip to the Gahanna Water Plant in October. All Council members were invited to attend.

Discussion was held concerning a vacant property on West Bigelow Street. It was noted that currently this property is in compliance with current ordinances.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
