December 1, 2014

The December 1, 2014 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Rick Roberts, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. The minutes of the November 17, 2014 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the November 17, 2014 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

Mr. Rod Siddons, Frontier Community Services, addressed City Council and presented information on Wyandot Senior Apartments Phase 2 to be located on East Wyandot Avenue and west of the existing Phase 1. The proposed Phase 2 would be located on approximately 8.5 acres and include an additional forty-eight (48) units. Mr. Siddons stated that there is a strong waiting list for these apartments. Mr. Roberts indicated that he would like to give City Council members the opportunity to review the information that was presented.

Mayor Washburn reported that the City is scheduled to ring the Salvation Army bell at Wal-Mart later this week from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and he has a signup sheet for those willing to help.
