

CITY COUNCIL

January 13, 2014

The January 13, 2014 special City Council meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. in Council Chambers by Rick Roberts, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Kyle McColly, Rick Roberts, Tom Shumaker, Don Spiegel, Scot Swinehart, Bill Thornton, and Bob Blocksom.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Alissa Paoella, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The purpose of this meeting was to address legislation for two Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) repaving projects.

A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to place Ordinance No. 151-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, WYANDOT COUNTY, OHIO, IN THE MATTER OF THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED IMPROVEMENT AND TO REQUEST THE COOPERATION OF THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 151-12 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 151-12. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 151-12 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, to place Ordinance No. 152-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, WYANDOT COUNTY, OHIO, IN THE MATTER OF THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED IMPROVEMENT AND TO REQUEST THE COOPERATION OF THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 152-12 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to suspend the rules of the Municipal Charter calling for separate readings on different days. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to place Ordinance No. 152-12 on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 152-12 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Shumaker, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 152-12. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 152-12 was duly adopted.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
