

CITY COUNCIL

November 3, 2014

The November 3, 2014 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Scot Swinehart, President Pro-Tem. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Roxie Karg, Tom Shumaker, Don Spiegel, Scot Swinehart, Bill Thornton, and Bob Blocksom. Rick Roberts was absent.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Alissa Paoella, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the October 20, 2014 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the October 20, 2014 Tree Commission meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the October 20, 2014 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, to place Resolution No. 182-12 entitled, "A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President Pro-Tem declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Resolution No. 182-12 for the first time by title only.

It was reported that construction under the Eighth Street repaving and waterline replacement project, done in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation, has been completed. The roadway painting and some yard work needs to be finished.

City Council members reminded residents not to rake their leaves in the streets.

It was noted that the time that the traffic light located at the intersection of West Wyandot Avenue/Hazel Street is set to flash needs to be adjusted to conform with the time set by the Safety Committee of 12:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.

There being no further business, the President Pro-Tem declared the meeting adjourned.
