

CITY COUNCIL

July 20, 2015

The July 20, 2015 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Rick Roberts, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to place Ordinance No. 205-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A MACK CAB AND CHASSIS AND LEACH GARBAGE PACKER PLUS ACCESSORIES THROUGH THE FEDERAL PURCHASING PROGRAM.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 205-12 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Shumaker, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 205-12. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 205-12 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to place Ordinance No. 206-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE, ADOPT AND ENACT THE 2015 REPLACEMENT PAGES TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES: TO REPEAL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH: TO PUBLISH THE ENACTMENT OF NEW MATTER: AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 206-12 for the first time by title only.

It was noted that Mr. Aaron Schoenberger reported at the Service Committee meeting earlier this evening that the river pump will be installed on Wednesday, weather permitting, and Harris Electric will be doing the electrical work for this project.

It was noted that draft legislation for Wind Energy Systems was mailed to the members of City Council. This information will be presented in Ordinance form at the August 3, 2015 City Council meeting.

It was noted that the committee of three City Council members formed to review and adapt legislation to address unsightly yard items will be meeting on August 3, 2015 in Council Chambers at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Washburn thanked the Chamber of Commerce and Mr. Bill Sturgeon for the fireworks show held on July 3, 2015.

Mayor Washburn noted that the Chamber of Commerce Steak Fry will be held on Wednesday, August 12, 2015 at the fairgrounds, tickets to attend are \$20.00.

Mayor Washburn also noted that The Anderson's will be holding an open house on Friday, August 7, 2015 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
