

CITY COUNCIL

June 1, 2015

The June 1, 2015 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Rick Roberts, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Roxie Karg, Rick Roberts, Tom Shumaker, Scot Swinehart, Bill Thornton, and Bob Blocksom. Don Spiegel was absent.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Greg Moon, Wyandot County Economic Development Director; Susan Shupp, Aspen Energy Corporation; Morris Lear; Alissa Paoella, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the May 18, 2015 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

Mr. Greg Moon, Wyandot County Economic Development Director, addressed City Council and invited them to attend the 2015 Wyandot County Forum for all elected officials from Wyandot County, townships, and municipalities to be held on Tuesday, June 16, 2015 at Viceroy Hall (Shotzy's) beginning at 5:30 p.m. The forum is designed to exchange ideas and establish new relationships and is sponsored by North Central Electric Cooperative.

Ms. Susan Shupp, Aspen Energy Corporation, addressed City Council and presented information on aggregation programs and the possibility of placing a community aggregation program on the November general ballot. It was noted as a result of the aggregation program that grants are available to the City from the supplier or this savings could be passed onto the residential customers. It was also noted that separate ballot issues would be needed for gas and electric.

Mayor Washburn provided Ms. Karg with sample legislation from other communities obtained by Mr. Dave Westbrook, Zoning Inspector, concerning trash on residents' properties.

Mayor Washburn indicated that he would like to appoint Mr. Paul Huffman to the Park Board to fill the unexpired term of Ms. Sharri Racheter.

A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to approve the Mayor's appointment of Mr. Paul Huffman as a member of the Park Board. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

Mayor Washburn thanked Kokosing Construction Company for their work repaving as part of the City's 2015 Asphalt Paving Program. It was noted that the company was very good to work with.

The annual Relay for Life event will be held on Saturday, June 20, 2015 at the Upper Sandusky High School.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
