

CITY COUNCIL

November 16, 2015

The November 16, 2015 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Rick Roberts, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Scot Swinehart, Bill Thornton, Bob Blocksom, Roxie Karg, Rick Roberts, Tom Shumaker, and Don Spiegel.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Mark Droll, City Auditor; Keith Niederkohr, Parks Manager; Alissa Paoella, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the November 2, 2015 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the November 2, 2015 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the November 2, 2015 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the November 9, 2015 Planning Commission meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

Mr. Mark Droll, City Auditor, addressed City Council and indicated that the State has released the findings of the City's 2013/2014 audit. Mr. Droll explained areas to be worked on and noted that most suggestions have already been implemented or are being worked on.

Mr. Keith Niederkohr introduced himself to the members of City Council as he was newly promoted to the position of Parks Manager.

A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to remove Ordinance No. 212-12 from the table. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to place Ordinance No. 212-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 184-12, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2015, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 212-12 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 212-12. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 212-12 was duly adopted.

It was noted that representatives from the City attended the annual Wyandot County Economic Development dinner last weekend.

The Street Department will be picking up leaves for approximately two more weeks and they will be beginning to pick up leaves in the subdivisions.

Ms. Karg indicated that the next meeting of the Yard Maintenance Committee will be held on Tuesday, December 8, 2015 at 6:30 p.m.

It was noted that Mayor Washburn, Mr. Droll, and the Department Supervisors attended a recent Leadership Seminar held in Toledo.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
