

## CITY COUNCIL

March 7, 2016

The March 7, 2016 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to place Resolution No. 223-12 entitled, "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A HOUSING REVOLVING LOAN FUND ADMINISTRATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY AND THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT, AND DECLARING THIS AN EMERGENCY.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Resolution No. 223-12 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Thornton, for the adoption of Resolution No. 223-12. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Resolution No. 223-12 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to place Ordinance No. 224-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2016 DODGE RAM PICK-UP TRUCK AND ACCESSORIES.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 224-12 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Roberts, to place Ordinance No. 225-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A SKID STEER AND ACCESSORIES.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 225-12 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Blocksom, to place Ordinance No. 226-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH PETERMAN ASSOCIATES, INC. TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE SEWER SEPARATION PROJECT, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 226-12 for the first time by title only.

It was noted that the next meeting of the Yard Maintenance Committee will be held on Thursday, March 10, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.

Mr. Dale Risley, Wyandot County EMS, addressed City Council and indicated that the Wyandot County EMS has purchased a property located at the northeast corner of North Warpole Street and West Guthrie Street and plan to relocate to this site. Mr. Risley requested the City partner in seeking grant funding for this project.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to support a grant application by the County to relocate the EMS and authorize the Mayor to sign a Memorandum in support of the project. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

It was noted that the Service Committee has set spring clean-up within the City to be held during the week of April 25-29, 2016. Extra charges will be assessed for mattresses, couches, chairs, etc.

Mayor Washburn congratulated Mr. Brad Taylor, Street Department employee, for obtaining his Class I Waste Water Collection Operator license from the Ohio EPA.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
