

CITY COUNCIL

October 16, 2017

The October 16, 2017 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Bob Blocksom, Roxie Karg, Marc Mays, Rick Roberts, Don Spiegel, Bill Thornton, and Kenneth Wessler.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Mark Droll, City Auditor; John Walker; Aaron Korte; Tom Karcher; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the October 2, 2017 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the October 2, 2017 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the October 2, 2017 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the October 10, 2017 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Mays, to place Ordinance No. 21-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE APPLICATION FOR ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT TERRITORY CONTAINING 5.355 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, IN THE COUNTY OF WYANDOT, STATE OF OHIO, AND IN THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANE, TO THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 21-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts, seconded by Mr. Thornton, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 21-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 21-13 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Roberts, to place Ordinance No. 22-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 243-12, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2017, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 22-13 for the first time by title only.

Mr. Droll reviewed the Recapitulation Report for September 2017 with the members of City Council.

Mr. Droll also reviewed the findings from the recent State audit conducted by Rea and Associates.

Mayor Washburn reported that the City's new website is up and running and it is tablet and smart phone friendly.

Mayor Washburn announced that the Economic Development Dinner will be held on Monday, November 13, 2017 at the Community Center in Sycamore and City Council members interested in attending should contact his office.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
