June 19, 2017

The June 19, 2017 City Council meeting was called to order 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. At this time Mayor Washburn presented a Key to the City to Mr. Allen Boes, former Street and Sanitation Supervisor, in recognition of his thirty (30) years of service to the City and his recent retirement.

Mayor Washburn also indicated that he has a certificate to present to Mr. Shane Pack, 2017 Upper Sandusky High School graduate, for placing second at State in the discus. Mr. Pack was unable to attend this meeting.

Mr. Droll reviewed the recapitulation for May 2017 with the members of City Council.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Ms. Karg, to place Ordinance No. 8-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 243-12, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2017, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 8-13 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Mays, to place Ordinance No. 9-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AMENDMENT OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO, TO ZONE APPROXIMATELY 21.456 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, LOCATED TO THE NORTH OF THE CITY ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF NORTH WARPOLE STREET AND SOUTH SIDE OF STARFISH LANE AS GENERAL MANUFACTURING (GM).", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 9-13 for the first time by title only.

Mayor Washburn indicated that Mr. Brian Brown, a graduate of Upper Sandusky High School who is involved in harness racing, recently had two horses he trained place first and third in the One Million Dollar Pepsi North American Cup.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
