

CITY COUNCIL

March 19, 2018

The March 19, 2018 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Rick Roberts, Don Spiegel, Bill Thornton, John Walker, Kenneth Wessler, Aaron Korte, and Marc Mays.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Doug Weisenauer, candidate for State Representative; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the March 5, 2018 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the March 5, 2018 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the March 5, 2018 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the March 12, 2018 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

At this time Mr. Doug Weisenauer introduced himself as a candidate for State Representative for the 87<sup>th</sup> District. Mr. Weisenauer is currently serving his third term as a Crawford County Commissioner.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Walker, to place Resolution No. 35-13 entitled, "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF A COMMITTEE TO DEVELOP A STRATEGY TO PROTECT THE WATER SOURCES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Resolution No. 35-13 for the first time by title only.

It was noted that the City's annual Arbor Day Program will be held on Monday, April 30, 2018 beginning at 9:30 a.m. at Duck Pond Park.

It was also noted that the City will be hosting the 2018 Northwest Ohio Tree City USA Awards Celebration on Wednesday, April 18, 2018 at Trinity Evangelical Church. City Council members interested in attending will need to submit their names for registration.

Mayor Washburn reported that at the April 2, 2018 City Council meeting he will be honoring Upper Sandusky High School athletes Brett Montgomery, Abby Wenger, Noah Clary, and Conner Johnston.
