

CITY COUNCIL

March 5, 2018

The March 5, 2018 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Marc Mays, Rick Roberts, Don Spiegel, Bill Thornton, John Walker, and Kenneth Wessler. Aaron Korte was absent.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Droll, City Auditor; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the February 19, 2018 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the February 19, 2018 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

A motion was made by Mr. Mays, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to place Ordinance No. 34-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN NATIONAL INSURANCE COMPANY, TO PROVIDE AND ADMINISTER HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS FOR THE ELIGIBLE CITY EMPLOYEES FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2018, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 34-13 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Walker, to suspend the rules of the Municipal Charter calling for separate readings on different days. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, to place Ordinance No. 34-13 on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 34-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Mays, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 34-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 34-13 for the second time by title only.

Mr. Mays reminded residents to clean up after their dogs when taking them for a walk.

Mr. Spiegel reported that Spring Clean-Up for residential sanitation customers has been set for April 23 – 27, 2018.
