The June 14, 2010 Park Board meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Brenda Freehling, Acting Chairman. Park Board members present were Brenda Freehling, Sharri Racheter, and Kenneth Wessler. John Booth, Jim Schuster, and Paul Wagner were absent.

Park Board members reviewed a request from Mr. Jason Fagan to allow free swimming all day at the Harrison Smith Park pool on Wednesday, August 4, 2010 for the Salvation Army's "Back to School Fun Day", and all day on Friday, August 13, 2010 for the Wyandot County Youth Commission's "Sync or Swim" event. Park Board members voiced no objections to this request.

Park Board members also agreed that a free day of swimming will be allowed on Monday, August 16, 2010.
