The April 10, 2017 Park Board meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Kenneth Wessler, Chairman. Park Board members present were Jon Blackburn, Bob Blocksom, Paul Huffman, Jack Leonard, Kip Wentling, and Kenneth Wessler.

A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Blackburn, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$102,420.73. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the March 13, 2017 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each Park Board member, were approved as received.

Park Board members reviewed the following quotes received for liquid chlorine for the swimming pool:

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Wentling, to approve the quote for liquid chlorine for the swimming pool for the 2017 season from Miami Products & Chemical Co. dba KOK Products, Galena, Ohio for \$1.18 per gallon plus a \$9.00 delivery charge. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Park Board members reviewed a request from Friends of the Library to hold a chicken barbeque at Bicentennial Park on Tuesday, June 20, 2017 from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (or until sold out). It was noted that bicycle riders participating in the Great Ohio Bicycle Adventure (GOBA) will be in Upper Sandusky on this day and will be spending the night at the Wyandot County Fairgrounds. Park Board members voiced no objections to this request.

Applications received for lifeguards were presented to the Park Board. Mr. Wessler noted that Mrs. Deanna Piecha, Human Resource Officer, would like to go over the applications with Miss Catie Richman, Pool Manager.

The purchase of one swimsuit per lifeguard was discussed. Park Board members voiced no objections to this matter.

Mr. Niederkoehr indicated that he will be meeting with Miss Richman, Pool Manager, to go over things for the swimming pool.

Mr. Niederkoehr presented a quote from Reineke Motors, Inc. for the purchase of a 2017 Dodge Ram Tradesman regular cab 4x2 pick-up truck through the State Purchasing Program at a total cost of \$19,712.50. The truck will have a three year warranty and will replace the Park Department's Ford Ranger which will be sold on govdeals.com.

A motion was made by Mr. Leonard, seconded by Mr. Huffman, to approve the purchase of a 2017 Dodge Ram Tradesman pick-up truck at a total cost of \$19,712.50. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mr. Niederkoehr reported that the grant submitted to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to restock the pond in Harrison Smith Park has been awarded to the City.

Mr. Niederkoehr also reported that a meeting was held last week with representatives from the softball leagues regarding the upcoming softball season. It was noted that the City has purchased field conditioner and a new drag and replaced the pitching mounds. League representatives have reset the base pegs on the fields.

It was noted that many years ago Mr. Gerald Swankhouse painted the distances on the walking path in Stepping Stones Park. Mr. Wessler indicated that requests have been received for this information to be provided once again. Mr. Niederkohr stated that the Park Department is planning to reseal the walking paths in Stepping Stones Park and at the reservoir this summer. Mr. Niederkohr is currently obtaining prices for the materials for this work. The possibility of waiting to paint this information on the path until the resealing work is completed or the placement of signs containing this information was discussed.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
