

PARK BOARD

November 20, 2017

The November 20, 2017 special Park Board meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers by Kenneth Wessler, Chairman. Park Board members present were Bob Blocksom, Paul Huffman, Jack Leonard, Kip Wentling, and Kenneth Wessler. Jon Blackburn was absent.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Keith Niederkohr, Parks Manager; Mark Droll, City Auditor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Rick Roberts; John Walker; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The purpose of this meeting was to review a quote received for the park maintenance building addition and to possibly make a recommendation to City Council.

Mr. Niederkohr reviewed plans and a quote of \$169,863.00 received from BlueScope Construction for a 58' x 30' addition to the park maintenance building located in Harrison Smith Park. Mr. Niederkohr indicated that the Park Department currently has equipment stored at various locations throughout the City. This addition would double the size of the exiting park maintenance building and provide a centralized storage place for Park Department equipment and a work space for Park Department employees for projects completed during the winter months including painting and/or repairs of picnic tables, benches, trash cans, etc. It was noted that BlueScope Construction is part of the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) Contract solution, and Clouse Construction will serve as the prime subcontractor for this project.

Mr. Droll indicated that this project will be addressed in the City's 2018 Park Department budget, and funds in the Park Department budget will be reestablished under the City's 2019 budget as no other major expenses will be planned during this time frame.

A motion was made by Mr. Wentling, seconded by Mr. Leonard, to recommend to City Council to accept the quote of \$169,863.000 from BlueScope Construction, 1540 Genessee Street, Kansas City, MO 64102 for an addition to the park maintenance building under the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) Contract solution. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
