

SAFETY COMMITTEE

April 19, 2010

The April 19, 2010 special Safety Committee meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers by Chad Smith, Chairman. Safety Committee members present were Kyle McColly, Chad Smith, and Scot Swinehart.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Chanda Neely, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The purpose of this meeting was to again review the qualifications for an appointment for the position of fireman with the City of Upper Sandusky.

Safety Committee discussed including the following requirements to Section 133.02 Fireman's Qualifications: allowing a transfer from the City's Volunteer Fire Division; a valid Ohio driver's license; no criminal record other than minor traffic violations, and no more than four BMV points in the last two years; the execution and delivery to the Safety Committee or other appointing officer an Authorization to Release Information from such entities as requested by the City; fingerprinting for purposes of a criminal background investigation.

A motion was made by Mr. Smith, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to recommend the following requirements be included in Ordinance No. 24-12 to be presented to City Council following this meeting:

- Must be at least eighteen years of age and less than thirty-six years of age for an original appointment, unless transferring from a full-time paid fireman position with another Fire Department or transferring from the City's Volunteer Fire Division;
- Must have a valid Ohio driver's license;
- Must have no criminal record other than minor traffic violations, and no more than four
BMV points in the last two years;
- Must execute and deliver to the Safety Committee or other appointing officer an Authorization to Release Information from such entities as requested by the City;
- Must be fingerprinted for purposes of a criminal background investigation.

Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
