A motion was made by Mr. McColly, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$7,802.70. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the July 2, 2012 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Park Board member, were approved as received.

Kelly and Dave Rowe, residents of Edgewood Drive, addressed the Safety Committee expressing their concerns about traffic in Highland Acres Subdivision especially during the week of the upcoming Wyandot County Fair due to the closure of CH 50. Mrs. Rowe noted that vehicles speed through the area and drive through the stop signs without stopping, and she is concerned that the flow of traffic will increase during the fair and the incidents of speeding will also increase. Chief Olds indicated that the Police Department will increase their monitoring of this area.

Safety Committee members reviewed a notice from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control to transfer a liquor permit from Gas America Services Inc., 1605 East Wyandot Avenue, to Speedway LLC, 1605 East Wyandot Avenue. Safety Committee members voiced no objection to this transfer.

It was noted that the Street Department will be painting roadway lines in the near future throughout the City. Chief Olds will contact Mr. Allen Boes, Street Department Supervisor, concerning the roadway sign and lines on Comfort Lane.

Chief Sturgeon reported the following:

- The Fire Department's annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July Chicken barbeque sold out and no plans have been set for the proceeds from this event.
- The Firemens Festival held Saturday, July 28 was very successful. Appreciation was expressed for all of the support received.
- The Fire Department plans to hold the Firemens Festival again in 2013 with the event to be held the last Saturday in July.
- Fire calls have been quiet.
- The Fire Department purchased a dunk tank and will be renting the tank with consideration being given for the proceeds from the rentals to possibly be used for a scholarship.

Chief Olds reported the following:

- There was good cooperation between the Police Department and the Fire Department during the Firemens Festival and positive feedback was received.
- Three new auxiliary officers were hired recently, with one of the individuals already working on his own.

Safety Committee members expressed appreciation to the Fire Department for their organization of the Firemens Festival.

A motion was made by Mr. McColly, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to enter into an executive session to discuss the Firefighters' Labor Agreement. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried. Upon completion of the executive session, the Safety Committee reconvened into regular session.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
