Chief Olds also reported that detour signs will be placed in the Highland Acres Subdivision during the week of the Wyandot County Fair to reroute traffic due to the closure of CH 50. It was noted the resurfacing of Edgewood Drive will take place in two weeks.

Chief Olds indicated that the Police Department's Records Management System was put into motion recently.

Chief Sturgeon reported that full-time Firefighter Robert Orr has completed six months work with the City and the Safety Committee members have completed their evaluation him.

There being no further business, the Acting Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
