A motion was made by Mr. McColly, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$20,130.94. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the September 3, 2013 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

It was noted that the date and time for Trick-or-Treat as established at the September 3, 2013 Safety Committee meeting will be Saturday, October 26, 2013 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Washburn presented a request received concerning the traffic light at the intersection of West Wyandot Avenue and Hazel Street. Safety Committee members were asked to consider setting this light to blink at all times as the truck traffic on Wyandot Avenue having to stop and start at the light is causing wear and tear on the roadway. Safety Committee members expressed their concerns for children crossing the road at this intersection before and after school and agreed not to change the light.

Chief Yeater reported the following:

- The Fire Department's annual Open House will be held on Saturday, October 12, 2013 from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- School presentations for grades Kindergarten thru 4th were completed on Friday.
- The aerial truck is currently out of service as some of the bracing is bent, and they are currently waiting to hear about the repair of the truck.
- Interviews are being conducted for new volunteer members of the Fire Department.
- The live burn on the home that was previously reported is not going to happen as the cost to remove the asbestos from the home would have been approximately \$15,000.00.

Captain Heil reported the following:

- The Police Department is ready to begin the interview process for new police officers from the eligibility list established in May 2013.
- The Police Department has been working with the Fire Department making plans for the upcoming concrete work to be done at the front of the Fire Department's fire bays.
- Chief Olds returned to work today, after being off due to an accident.

The Safety Committee thanked Captain Heil for filling in while Chief Olds was off work.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the motion carried.
