The minutes of the January 5, 2015 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the January 19, 2015 special Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Chief Olds reported that the background investigations and psychological examinations have been completed on the police officer candidates being considered for hire. The physical examinations are scheduled for next week; pending the results of the physical examination the hiring process can proceed.

Chief Olds indicated that he has been working with Melissa Lee, US Fitness, on optional 5K routes within the parks and at the reservoir. Chief Olds noted that he has one additional contact to make concerning these routes.

Safety Committee members reviewed the following bid received for the three (3) year lease of two (2) 2015 police cruisers:

Chief Olds presented a quote for camera systems for these cruisers at a cost of \$4,795.00 for each cruiser, and \$9,640.00 for both cruisers including financing. The lease payments for these cruisers including financing is \$22,283.19 per year for three (3) years and \$66,849.57 total.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to recommend to City Council to approve the three (3) year lease of two (2) 2015 police cruisers from Reineke Motors, Inc. and camera systems with lease payments, including financing, per year totaling \$22,283.19 and \$66,849.57 total for three (3) years. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning the need for a traffic light on CH 330 east of the US 23 interchange. Possible locations for a traffic light in this area were discussed. Chief Olds indicated that traffic in the area would benefit more by the light being located at the US 23 northbound exit and entrance ramps. Safety Committee members requested Mayor Washburn contact a representative from the Ohio Department of Transportation and request a traffic count be conducted in this area.

Chief Olds reported that a promotional Police Lieutenant civil service examination will be held on Wednesday, March 4, 2015 with five Police Officers having expressed an interest in taking the examination.

Chief Yeater reported on the home that is being offered for burn training. The asbestos removal will take place next week and the burn training will take place in the spring.

Chief Yeater also explained a potential grant opportunity for the Fire Department.

Chief Yeater also reported on recent fire calls.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
