A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Shumaker, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$26,483.09. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the May 4, 2015 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Dr. Isaac Orians addressed the Safety Committee and requested the first parking space along the west side of North Fifth Street just north of East Wyandot Avenue, that was previously a handicap parking space, be returned as a handicap parking space. Safety Committee members voiced no objections to this request.

Safety Committee members reviewed a request to close portions of North Eighth Street and West Finley Street for the St. Peter's Festival to be held on Saturday, June 13, 2015.

A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Shumaker, to allow the street closures as requested for the St. Peter's Festival on Saturday, June 13, 2015. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mayor Washburn presented a request to close a portion of Houpt Drive, in front of the Upper Sandusky High School Athletic Complex, during the Relay for Life event to be held on Saturday, June 20, 2015 for a motorcycle stunt rider to perform. After considerable discussion the Safety Committee agreed to not close the street and to not allow the stunt rider to perform on the street.

Mr. Yeater reported that annual testing of equipment at the Fire Department is in progress.

Captain Ross reported that the Police Department will take delivery tomorrow of the two new police cruisers ordered from Reineke Motors. The vehicles will be delivered to D.R. Ebel in Toledo, Ohio on Wednesday for detailing.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
