Mr. Thornton indicated that he is working with the Upper Sandusky Middle School on a Zombie 5K Run being planned and they will be using the preplanned route through Stepping Stones Park.

Chief Yeater reported that repairs on the Fire Department's aerial truck are still in progress.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
