Mrs. Brenda Moore, 118 West Walker Street, addressed the Safety Committee indicating that she lives adjacent and across the alley to the west of A & A Grocery and she has experienced problems with semi delivery trucks running over her bushes in her yard and nearly hitting the utility poles located along the alley. Mrs. Moore noted that she has talked to the owners of the grocery concerning these issues. Mrs. Moore also requested consideration of the alley being made one way as cars traveling the alley will drive into her yard to get over for oncoming traffic. Chief Olds stated that trucks cannot be stopped from using public alleys for deliveries, but Mrs. Moore should contact the Police Department immediately when incidents occur. Chief Olds noted that the Police Department will monitor the area.

The date and time for trick-or-treat was discussed. It was noted that the Elks are having their annual Halloween walk-thru on Saturday, October 31, 2015 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to set trick-or-treat within the City to be held on Saturday, October 31, 2015 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Chief Yeater reported that the aerial truck was due for its five year test and testing began on Friday, August 28, 2015 and some issues were found and those repairs are being addressed. Following those repairs, testing of the pump and waterways will be conducted.
