A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Roberts, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$23,813.16. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the March 6, 2017 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Jim Rhoden and Mr. Irvin Woods, Wyandot Classics and Cruisers, addressed the Safety Committee and indicated that they would like to hold their annual Autumn Cruise in the downtown area on Saturday, September 23, 2017.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Roberts, to approve the annual Autumn Cruise to be held in the downtown area on Saturday, September 23, 2017. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mr. Thornton reported that there is a 5K run being planned to benefit the 8<sup>th</sup> grade field trip to be held in the morning on either Saturday, May 20, 2017 or Saturday, May 27, 2017, beginning and ending in Stepping Stones Park with the route to travel thru residential areas on the east side of town. Mr. Thornton indicated that they will need to utilize the large gazebo in Stepping Stones Park.

Chief Olds reported on a letter of resignation received from Police Dispatcher Melissa Breidenbach, effective April 13, 2017.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Wessler, to accept the resignation of Police Dispatcher Melissa Breidenbach. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Chief Olds requested consideration of the creation of a fourth Police Lieutenant position within the Police Department. It was noted that this position would not add any additional personnel to the Police Department staff as the Police Officer position vacated by the promotion of an Officer to this position would not be filled. A civil service promotional examination will have to be held for a Police Lieutenant.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Roberts, to approve a fourth Police Lieutenant position within the Police Department and request the Civil Service Commission proceed with a promotional examination for this position. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Chief Yeater reported that the equipment to roll supply hose has been ordered, which partial funding was awarded through the Bureau of Workers' Compensation, as reported at the March 6, 2017 Safety Committee meeting.

Chief Yeater also noted that the Fire Department is looking to possibly submitting another Bureau of Workers' Compensation Grant in four to six weeks which could provide 100% funding for a gear washer which is estimated to cost between \$8,000.00 and \$9,000.00.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
