A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Wessler, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$10,808.67. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the September 4, 2018 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Safety Committee members reviewed a notice from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control for Don Tomassos LLC, 123 West Wyandot Avenue.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to not request a hearing for this notice. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mr. Roberts read a notice from Fire Chief Lynn Yeater of his retirement from the Upper Sandusky Fire Department effective December 30, 2018 after twenty-five (25) years of service with the department.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to accept, with regret, the notice of retirement from Fire Chief Lynn Yeater effective December 30, 2018. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Chief Yeater reported on the following:

- Fire Safety Week is October 7 – 13, 2018 and the Fire Department is working with the schools to visit the schools during that week.
- The Fire Department's annual Open House will be held at the station on Saturday, October 13, 2018 from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- The Fire Department is planning to again provide lighting at the intersection of East Wyandot Avenue and Fourth Street, near the Elks Lodge, on the night of Trick-or-Treat and the Elks Walk-Thru.
- The Fire Department is planning to again host the costume judging and cider and donuts provided to the public by the American Legion on the night of the annual Halloween Parade.

Mr. Wessler shared a thank you he received from a resident to the Fire Department for changing the batteries in their smoke detector. Chief Yeater indicated that the Fire Department does this as a public service. Chief Yeater also noted that recently the Fire Department installed a smoke detector for a resident who is legally blind and deaf that will shake this individual's bed in such an emergency.

Chief Ross reported the following:

- The Police Department is preparing to take donations for candy to be handed out at the Police Department during Trick-or-Treat.
- Chief Ross congratulated Chief Yeater on his upcoming retirement and noted that working with Chief Yeater has been outstanding.
- The civil service examination for police officer applicants was held on Saturday, September 29, 2018. The City is currently waiting on the results from this exam.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
