Discussion was held concerning leaf pickup at Parkway Mobile Homes on North Warpole Street. The Service Committee determined that due to this being private property the leaves would be collected in the parking area.

Discussion was held concerning the purchase of a combo vacuum/sewer truck for use by the Service Department. The Service Committee determined that this purchase would not be economically feasible at this time.

Discussion was held concerning the possibility of installing LED lighting in the street lights downtown. Mr. Allen Boes, Street Supervisor, will obtain more information regarding this matter.

Discussion was held with Mr. Dave Westbrook, Water Plant Supervisor, regarding the status of the new water tower. Mr. Westbrook also reported on a meeting between URS and the Ohio EPA concerning the Water Plant.

Discussion was held concerning a request from the WODA Group for the construction of 10 unit senior housing development at Essex Way. This matter was referred to the Law Director for his review.

Mayor Washburn reported on a final walk thru on Thursday, October 29th, 2009 for the Custom Ag Project on North Warpole Street.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
