A motion was made by Mr. Dale Rowe, seconded by Mr. Hank Latham, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$72,903.12. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the August 2nd, 2010 Service Committee meeting having been mailed to each member, were approved as received.

Mr. & Mrs. Jon Grundtisch, 515 Parkview Drive, addressed the Service Committee concerning a request from Mr. Scott Pagnard, regarding the possibility of relocating storm tiles in the Stone Crossing Golf Course area along East Wyandot Avenue in order to redirect the water flow. Mr. & Mrs. Grundtisch voiced their concerns regarding this project. It was determined that a meeting with all adjoining property owners would be conducted before any decisions regarding this project were completed.

Mr. Dave Westbrook, Water Plant Supervisor, updated the Service Committee on the status of the new water plant.

Mr. Dave Westbrook, Water Plant Supervisor, requested permission to repair the #5 Dodge pickup. Mr. Westbrook will obtain a quote for these repairs.

Mr. Allen Boes, Street Department Supervisor, requested permission to repair the sewer jet for a cost of \$4,227.47 from Finley Fire Equipment, McConnelsville, Ohio. A motion was made by Mr. Gary Veith, seconded by Mr. Dale Rowe, for the approval of these repairs. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning a letter received regarding drainage issues in Wards Subdivision. This matter was referred to the Law Director.

Discussion was held concerning the lease of a street striper for a cost of \$387.50 per day from the Hug Manufacturing Company, Norwalk, Ohio. The Service Committee authorized this lease.

Discussion was held concerning the repaving of St. Rt. 199/ North Warpole Street. Legal correspondence has been forwarded to ODOT.

Mr. Aaron Putnam, Wastewater Treatment Plant Supervisor, reported that an EPA public hearing will be held on Tuesday, August 24th, 2010 at 5:30 p.m. in Council Chambers regarding a mercury variance for the W.W.T.P.

Discussion was held concerning a potential leak on Wyandot Avenue. Mr. Westbrook requested permission to hire a leak detection company to locate the leak on Wyandot Avenue and for the baby pool at the park. The Service Committee authorized this request.

The Service Committee noted that the September 6th, 2010 Service Committee meeting would be changed to September 7th, 2010 in observance of Labor Day.
