A motion was made by Mr. Dale Rowe, seconded by Mr. Hank Latham, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$51,224.09. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the July 19<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each member, were approved as received.

Discussion was held concerning the repaving of St. Rt. 199/ North Warpole Street. Mr. Allen Boes, Street Department Supervisor, reported that a portion of this street has been ground and re-paving will be completed soon.

Discussion was held concerning the possibility of relocating storm tiles in the Stone Crossing Golf Course area along East Wyandot Avenue in order to redirect the water flow. Mr. Allen Boes, Street Supervisor, will meet with the appropriate property owners regarding this matter.

Discussion was held concerning the condition of the railroad tracks on Lincoln Highway/330. It was noted that the railroad has been contacted regarding this matter.

Discussion was held concerning the mowing of weeds along the railroads throughout the city. It was noted that the city will be mowing these areas and costs will be submitted to the railroad.

Mayor Washburn noted that lawns with weeds/grass ten inches or higher will be mowed by the city and property owners will be billed for these services.

Discussion was held concerning a request from Mr. Dave Eippert regarding the need for repair of infrastructure in the area of North Warpole Street.

Discussion was held concerning a request for soil from the reservoir. It was noted that due to fact that citizens did not put the soil back to mowing condition, the city will no longer allow soil removal from this area.

Mayor Washburn congratulated Allen Boes, Dave Schneider, Eric Yeater and Mark Nutter on their completion of wastewater licenses through the EPA.

Discussion was held concerning a fall cleanup for city residents. The Service Committee established a date of September 27<sup>th</sup> through October 1<sup>st</sup> for this clean-up.

Mr. Dave Westbrook, Water Plant Supervisor, updated the Service Committee on the progress of the new water plant.

Discussion was held concerning the demolition of the old water plant on Sycamore Street.

Discussion was held concerning the status of the report from Peterman and Associates for the water flows report. It was noted that this report should be completed soon.

Mr. Allen Boes, Street Supervisor, reported that the grater used by the Service Department is in need of repair.

The Service Committee then took a tour of Ward's Subdivision to view some drainage issues in this area.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
